- Mr Cavanagh provided an update on the development of the Safety Health Management System, and advised of mining contractor partner selection.
- Mr Callan provide an update on the proposed mine design The proposed work roster is seven on seven off for the work force and five on two off for management, accommodation based in Dysart.

Advice was provided on a number of matters by Inspectors to assist the SSE in meeting the objectives of the Act and subordinate legislation.
